INTERNATIONAL CONTEST RESULTS (for Pioneer)
Pioneer District had three quartets compete in the international contest this summer. *The Hemidemisemi-quaver 4* finished 37<sup>th</sup> out of 51 quartets with an average of 78.5% *Upper Deck* finished 35<sup>th</sup> with an average of 78.9% and *Frontier* finished 18<sup>th</sup> with an average of 82.1% *Frontier* also competed in the "International Next Generation Varsity Barbershop Quartet Contest", formerly called the College Quartet Contest, and **they took the Gold** medal out of 20 competing quartets. Grand Rapids *Great Lakes Chorus* came in 17<sup>th</sup> out of 30 competing choruses with an average of 82.4%
